

Weekly lists of applications and list of extant applications

Delivering planning reforms in Fife

Fife Council's Weekly List of Applications changed as of 6th April 2009. These are now set out slightly differently and contain more information as required by the new planning legislation. Most of the changes were already in use by Fife Council prior to April 2009.

The main changes introduced were as follows:

- The list is split into two sections – the first section includes applications for planning permission made to the Planning Authority and the second section includes Proposal of Application Notices (PANs) where applicable. (i.e. national and major developments.)
- The reference number given to the application, the site location, the name of the applicant and agent, including the name and address of the agent.
- A description of the proposed development and the date of expiry of the period within which the application cannot be determined.
- The weekly list also contains a statement as to how further information on an application may be obtained from Fife Council.
- The weekly list is published on www.fifedirect.org.uk
- The weekly list is made available for inspection at Development Services offices in Cupar, Dunfermline, Kirkcaldy and Glenrothes and at all public libraries in Fife.
- The weekly list is also sent to every Community Council at weekly intervals. Community Councils may request formal consultation on particular applications in accordance with PAN 47 'Community Councils and Planning'.
- Fife Council retains a list of all people and organisations who receive the weekly list.

Fife Council monitors and reviews the effectiveness of its weekly lists for customers and has also introduced:

- Breakdown of applications received by Councillor Ward Areas.
- Links within www.fifedirect.org.uk
- Detailed suffixes to describe the type of application submitted.

List of Extant Applications

Fife Council as the Planning Authority will be required to provide a list of extant applications, which is to be accessible to the public.

Extant applications are all applications which are still being actively assessed and proposed by Fife Council, and no formal decision notice has been issued.

The list of extant applications follows the same format as the Weekly List of Applications but separates the applications into two different groups.

- Pending Consideration: This refers to applications which are still being assessed and have not yet been finalised or reported to Committee.
- Pending Decision: Applications which are pending a decision have been formally assessed and been to Committee where required. Applications pending include:
 - Applications agreed at Committee but subject to a legal agreement which is still being finalised between the parties.
 - Applications which are on Committee Agendas awaiting the Committee decision.
